

Medical certificate for incapacity for work occurring during an annual holiday period

I, the undersigned, Doctor of Medicine, certify that I have interviewed this day:

The submission of this medical certificate by the worker means that he/she is asserting his/her right to carry forward holidays not taken due to incapacity for work which occurred during the holidays (in accordance with the Royal Decree of 30 March 1967 determining the general terms and conditions for the implementation of the laws on annual holidays for salaried workers), without this automatically implying an extension of the said holidays. Except in cases of force majeure, this medical certificate must be sent to the employer within 2 days of the onset (or extension) of the incapacity for work, unless a different deadline is stipulated in a collective labour agreement or working rules.
